# 3- Transports in Lisbon

#### How to get tickets?

You can buy the Lisbon transport's card directly at the metro station of the Airport.

There are ticket office or automatic machine, with an english option. In the city, you can buy and recharge cards at the metro stations, Carris mob points, CTT Post Offices and Payshop agents (mostly tobacco and newspaper shops.



The card is rechargeable. It costs 0,50 €. The card can only be used by one person, so each one must have his own card.

You should keep the card with you and recharge it with **two possible options**:


**1)** Zapping - Prepaid stored value card. You can charge an amount  $(3 \in , 5 \in , 10 \in ...)$  onto your card, which is deducted as you validate the card on different transports: metro, bus, tram, and boat. With Zapping, one way (= one hour) costs **1,30**€. If you change mean of transport it cost another ticket. For exemple if you take the metro then the bus, it will cost 2 x 1,30 € = 2,60 €.

On urban train it costs 1,85 €

- 2) Single way ticket Valid for unlimited travel by bus, tram, lift, funicular and metro, for 1 hour (between the first and last entrance validation) and it costs 1.45€.
- In the bus, you can always buy a single ticket on board directly to the driver, and it costs 1,85 €.

#### **METRO MAP**





#### From the airport to the venue (Liceu Camões)

The simplest and fast is to take the metro - Red line, then change line at SALDANHA station, take the Yellow line (direction Rato) until PICOAS station



Then take **Rua Tomas Ribeiro** (corner with Banco BIC) and you'll arrive in Praça José Fontana. The Liceu Camões is in front of you.



**Attention:** it is recommended to be at the airport at least 2 hours before your flight time, as the airport is usually full and the delay can be long.

#### INDIVIDUAL ACCOMMODATION

"Besides the free collective accommodation (see next page), within walking distance, we can suggest:
(The prices are indicative)

#### Fontana Guesthouse

double room = 48 € / night

#### **Hub Lisbon Patio Hostel**

1 bed in 8bed bedroom: 14 € / night

1 double room: 48 € / night

#### Hotel White Lisboa

(standard double room = 77 € /night)

#### Be Lisbon Hotel

( double room = 68 € / night)

#### Nest House Lisbon Hotel

(double room = 53 € / night)

And you can find other possibilities also close and cheap.

#### **COLLECTIVE ACCOMMODATION**

There is a **free** accommodation available at the venue of the event (Liceu Camões)

It is located in the sport hall of the Liceu Camões, where you can have a space to sleep. It is like this:



It is necessary to make a registration to sleep in the sport hall: registration page

You should bring your own mattress and sleeping-bag.


There are 3 showers.
