

We, now.

- 1. The root cause of the social and ecological crises is capitalism**, by which we mean the global socioeconomic system based on the private property of the means of production and driven by profit. This implies that a necessary precondition for the task of solving these crises is to dismantle capitalism.
 - 2. This is about class struggle.** This is about racial and gender oppression that capitalism relies on. Our analysis is that the working class must rise against the capitalist class and all of its institutions in order to stop the collapse of civilization.
 - 3. The climate crisis gives us a time-frame to dismantle capitalism**, an ever-diminishing time-frame that can be calculated with the fingers of two hands. The global carbon budget for 1.5°C warming is expected to be consumed by this decade. This is the climate realistic time frame to dismantle capitalism while simultaneously cutting emissions.
 - 4. The task is global.** Articulation of locally decided strategies is not an adequate response. The organization and the execution of the movement must be at the global level. This implies resource allocation for international coordination and mandate building for international organization.
 - 5. We will organize a revolution.** Everyone has failed so far, including ourselves. This is not about what other people should do. We will not delegate our responsibility to other entities, other organizations, other individuals. We will not avoid accountability by referring to abstractions like “the people” or “the class”. No excuses. It is *our* task to organize an ecosocialist revolution.
 - 6. This is a commitment to a task**, not an analysis or a position statement. No blah blah blah on our side. This is about action. We commit to organizing the action necessary to fulfill the task at hand.
 - 7. This is a commitment to agility and to priority.** No distractions. Our house is on fire.
- We now** launch the organizational process that takes the climate crisis seriously.
